

'Great Balls of Fire!' Street Theatre Fire Show

Technical Specifications

This show combines high skill fire and crystal ball manipulation, comedy and audience participation to leave your audience laughing, entertained and in awe. Show length can be from 5 to 45 minutes, usually performed outdoors this show can also be tailored to work indoors upon request.

Show requirements

Performance area

- Stage width – 8m
- Stage depth – 4m (with a back to the stage)/8m (in the round)
- Height clearance – 4m
- This show can be modified to be performed in smaller spaces or indoors upon request.
- Most flat even surfaces are suitable for this show. Where there is risk of an unsuitable surface such as wet or muddy grass or other slippery surfaces carpet will need to be provided to cover the performance area. This can be provided by Truan if necessary.
- Stage area must be free of flammable materials or props and drapes.
- Performance area may remain slippery for approximately 10mins after show, until fuel residue has evaporated. Guest and other performers need to be made aware of this.
- Client is responsible for ensuring fire shows are permitted at venue, and if any sprinkler systems or smoke alarms are in operation.

Fire Safety

- Truan will provide fire blankets and extinguishers for bookings in the UK. As fire extinguishers cannot be flown they will need to be provided by the client for all bookings abroad.

Sound

- A PA and head mic will be provided by Truan suitable for up to audiences of 500.
- For larger audiences a suitable, good quality and loud PA must be provided which Truan will connect his head mic to via a ¼inch Jack connector. Also a CD player or iPod cable and operator will be required.

Lighting

- This show is suitable to be performed during the day or at night (performance enhanced with show area illuminated).

Backstage

- Secure, warm room requested, large enough for changing and warm up.

Set up and rehearsal

- Truan will require 30 minutes to warm up and 30 minutes to set up stage area. Please allow an extra 30 minutes to an hour if a technical run through is required with the sound operator (for over 500 people).

Insurance

- Truan has Public Liability Insurance up to £10,000,000
- Truan has Public Liability Fire Insurance up to £2,000,000
